**SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS**

**Discussion Concerning Access Monitoring**

Discussion ensued regarding information contained in the database that the Master Association utilizes and concerns regarding whether any personal information could potential become subject to public records. It was determined that the CDD would only be given read-only access to a portion of the database which contains basic information such as name, address, and transponder number.

All parties agreed it was most efficient to continue to have the Master Association, by way of its management entity, The Continental Group, issue transponders and upload information to the database. It was discussed that an agreement should be drafted between the Master Association and the CDD, and The Continental Group which outlines the process, as well as contain provisions relating to responsibility of The Continental Group to cooperate with the Association and CDD in turning over database information in the event the cease to be the management entity for the Association.

Mr. Dengler, Mr. Boldiga, Mr. Sherman and Stock Development's IT representative will work together to work up a proposal for software and computer upgrades that will be needed to


integrate the CDD system with The Continental Groups' system.


Ms. Syvret noted that current orders for the gatehouse should also be reviewed during this process and new orders posted if necessary.
