

# Important Resident information for the Gate System at Paseo

## Resident Access

→ **RFID Transponder** attached to the vehicle\*. The *RFID Reader*, mounted on the left side of the inbound lane before the gate, will automatically read the Transponder and open the gate for authorized vehicles; no action is required by the driver.

**\*Transponders must be attached to the windshield** using the self-adhesive backing, to function reliably, Transponders laying on the dash, in the console, held in hand, held on with scotch tape, stuck to rear view mirror, visor, ect..., will function erratically, if at all. The transponder contains a small radio transmitter that uses the windshield as part of its antenna. The transponder will not function reliably if it is too close to metal, electronics, or your body/hand.

Transponder installation: Transponders are self adhesive, we recommend that you clean the windshield, peel off the backing and position the Transponder horizontally, inside, upper left hand corner (driver's side) with the numbers "right-side-up". Leave 2" between the Transponder and the metal windshield frame, press firmly.

If your windshield has a *metallic* tint strip, the transponder must be 2" below the strip.

## Visitor Access

Visitors enter by stopping at the Guard, stating who they are and who they are visiting, the Guard will check the Resident's "Pre-cleared Visitor List", or call the resident, then record name, license plate, and grant entry.

Please complete and return a "Resident Questionnaire" so the correct information can be listed with the Guardhouse and programmed into the call box for visitors.
