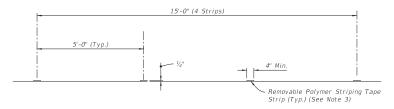

- Zone 1 Penzance, Guardhouse & Paseo Grande
- Zone 2 Condos, west of Paseo Grande,
- Zone 3 Condos, east of Paseo Grande
- Zone 4 Rosalinda, Provencia, Mercado & Sarita (includes Bibiana to Emilia and Javiera to Nalda)
- Zone 5 Paseo Drive (starting at Paseo Grande and including bridge)
- Zone 6 Adelio. Dario & Adora
- Zone 7 Esteban, (both sides) & Macario
- Zone 8 Hidalgo, Falisto & Renata
- Annuals are not looking optimal in front of Paseo monument in lake on East end of Penzance close to Palomino Ln. intersection. These are worse than last inspection. What will be done in this area?
- During this inspection, Pinnacle is working on the dead and fruit in the palms along Penzance from Palomino Ln. to Paseo Grande Blvd.
- Just noting the ditch is getting tall on Penzance. Hopefully, it will be mowable soon.
- Need to make sure moving is being completed to the fire hydrant and conservation sign on Penzance East of the condos.
- 5. There is Firebush growing within the Arboricola on Penzance ROW across the street and just West of Musket Ln.

- 6. 5 dead palms on the Penzance ROW between Palomino Ln. and Paseo Grande Blvd. Have these been proposed for removal?
- 7. There are 3 dead palms on Penzance between Paseo Grande Blvd. to West end. Have these been proposed for removal?
- Diagnose and treat declining Arboricola on the Southside of the bike path between Paseo Grande Blvd. and Palomino Ln. in the standalone island beds.
- Weeds growing up within the Arboricola after the first pillar on Penzance West of Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 10. Weeds have been treated and path mowed on Penzance West of Paseo Grande Blvd. May need to remove some of the dead weeds.



- 11. Couple Coconut palms and Foxtail palms with dead hanging fronds and fruiting structures on Penzance from Paseo Grande Blvd. to West end of property.
- 12. Struggling Perennial flowers have been removed at the bullnose of Paseo Grande Blvd. and Penzance intersection. Will the gaps be replaced?
- 13. Clean out any dead material in the Bromeliads at entrance median on Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 14. Bush Daises are struggling that replaced the annuals in front of the Paseo monument on the median before the guard gate on Paseo Grande Blvd. What can be done to improve these?
- 15. Remove Cardboard Palms growing up through the shrubs on the backend of the first median on Paseo Grande Blvd. before entering the gate.
- 16. Perennials at the bullnose of the median splitting guests and residents are failing. What is the plan for this? (Pic. 16)



17. Diagnose and treat the declining Arboricola in the median splitting guests and residence before the guard house. Remove any dead material.

- 18. Purple Queen ground cover is looking a little better but not optimal on the two median bullnoses after you go through the guard gate before Herminia St.
- 19. Noting on Paseo Grande Blvd. in the pavers path around the pond and parking spots have improved with weed control. There are a couple small ones but overall great job.
- 20. Vines growing on top of the shrubs along the lake bank on East side of Paseo Grande Blvd. between light poles #99 and #100.

21. It appears a vehicle has run over the turf at the roundabout on the Eastside of Paseo Grande Blvd. and left ruts. Can these be smoothed out? If not, a proposal will be needed to repair. (Pic. 21)



- 22. Petit Ixora are starting to turn yellow again by the East roundabout on Paseo Grande Blvd. between light poles #100 and #101.
- 23. Prune out dead material in the Nora Grant Ixora behind light pole #104.
- 24. Prune the Nora Grant Ixora a few inches lower at the gazebos to create a terracing effect to see the Arboricola behind them.
- 25. Diagnose and treat the Foxtail Palm just North of light pole #109 on East side of Paseo Grande Blvd.



- 26. Diagnose and treat the declining turf near the electrical box by light pole #46 on Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 27. Dead hanging Coconut Palm frond behind light pole #57 on Paseo Grande Blvd.

28. Treat the sedge in the bed growing under the



- 29. Prune the dead fronds in the newly planted Pygmy Date Palms in front of the dumpster on Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 30. Treat random areas of sedge in the turf on Paseo Grande Blvd. on the Westside.
- 31. Remove vines growing on shrubs along the lake bank on the West side of Paseo Grande Blvd. behind light pole #72. (Pic. 31)



- 32. Remove dead material in the Nora Grant Ixora at the Northwest gazebo.
- 33. A vehicle also drove through the turf at the West roundabout on Paseo Grande Blvd. Can this be smoothed out? If not, a proposal will be needed to repair.
- 34. Petit Ixora yellowing at the West roundabout as well behind light pole #80. Treat accordingly.
- 35. Diagnose and treat the declining turf at the Southwest gazebo behind light pole #85. (Pic. 35)



- 36. Diagnose and treat a Nora Grant Ixora at the Southwest gazebo right next to the path into it.
- 37. Weeds growing up through the shrubs on Herminia St. between East and West Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 38. Diagnose and treat the Foxtail Palm and turf in front of condo 11256 on Eastside of Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 39. Diagnose and treat the Foxtail Palm in front of condo 6112 on Eastside of Paseo Grande Blvd.
- 40. Noting new tree rings were mulch with adequate depth in zone 1.



- Mulch has been installed on the new tree rings except on Bibiana after you pass light post #116.
- 2. Dead frond in a Foxtail palm across the street from Provencia.
- 3. Treat weeds in beds behind light pole #131 on Bibiana Way.
- 4. Diagnose and treat the declining Nora Grant Ixora in the bed behind light pole #131.
- 5. Treat broadleaf turf weeds and sedge by light pole #134 on Bibiana Way.
- 6. Treat broadleaf turf weeds at the intersection of Emilia St. and Bibiana Way.
- 7. Light pole #158 on Bibiana is hiding inside a tree canopy. Expose the best you can.
- 8. Diagnose and treat the tree by light pole #159 on Bibiana Way. (Pic. 8)
- Similar to zone 1, paver weeds are better controlled in zone 2 but there are a couple small ones here and there.
- 10. There is a dead Foxtail palm across the street from light pole #163 on Bibiana Way. Investigate and report why this may have died. (Pic. 10)



- 11. Schedule a pruning event for the shrub row along the aluminum fence shared with Penzance in zone 2.
- 12. Treat the weeds at the mailbox kiosk on Bibiana Way.
- 13. Remove vine growing on the shrubs along the aluminum fence on Bibiana Way behind light pole #166
- 14. Raise the Oak canopy over hanging Bibiana Way on the Southend.
- 15. Treat the weeds in the hedge bed along the aluminum fence behind the condos using light pole #173 as a reference.
- Dead Foxtail frond by light pole #175 on Bibiana Way.
- 17. Remove weeds growing up through the Ficus at the lift station on Emilia St.
- 18. Turf is looking better on Emilia St. ROW but need to treat the broadleaf weeds.
- 19. Foxtail Palm has died and needs to be replaced on Adoncia St. just West of light pole #224. This is one that has been monitored over past inspections and finally died. (Pic. 19)



- 20. Clean up Crinum Lilies at mailbox kiosk on Adoncia St.
- 21. Diagnose and treat the declining Foxtail Palm on Delicia St. across the street from light pole #183. I have not seen improvement with this tree. It has declined more from last report. (Pic. 21)



22. Raise the Oak canopies on Tulio St. on the Southend overhanging the road.



- Raise the Oak canopies that are getting low again on Palba Way by light pole #298.
- Declining and thin turf on Palba Way across the street of light pole #21. Fertilizer ban being lifted at the end of September should help.
- Raise the Oak canopies overhanging Palba Way on the Southend.
- Remove vines growing on top of the shrubs along the aluminum fence on Palba Way behind light pole #13.
- 5. Diagnose and treat declining turf on Izarra Way by light pole #282. (Pic. 5)



- Treat weeds at the mailbox kiosk on Izarra Way.
- 7. Diagnose and treat the Foxtail Palm across the street from light pole #289 on Izarra Way.
- Diagnose and treat the broadleaf turf weeds on Izarra Way across the street from Olinda Way. *No light pole #
- Diagnose and treat declining tree on Izarra Way just North of Olinda Way. *No light pole #
- 10. Damaged trees have been removed and stumps ground. Bare areas to be resolved.

 Treat broadleaf turf weeds near the intersection of Izarra Way and Paseo Grande Blvd. (Pic. 11)



- Treat broadleaf turf weeds on Olinda Way by light pole #304.
- 13. Diagnose and tread Foxtail Palm on Nalda St. across the street from light pole #25.
- 14. Treat weeds in pavers on sidewalk and parking area on Nalda St. across the street from light pole #243.
- 15. Schedule a pruning event for the shrubs shared with Penzance along the aluminum fence in zone 3.
- 16. Raise the Oak canopies overhanging the road on the South end of Nalda St.
- 17. Treat broadleaf turf weeds at the intersection of Kemena St. and Olivera St.
- 18. Noting a new Foxtail Palm has been installed for the one that died on Javiera Way by light pole #27.
- 19. New tree rings on Javiera Way have been mulched.
- 20. Dead frond in a Foxtail palm on Javiera Way between light poles #38 and 39.



- 1. Diagnose and treat a declining area of turf at the Sarita Ct. roundabout.
- 2. Diagnose and treat the Duranta in the bed at Sarita Ct. roundabout. Remove any dead material.
- 3. Petit Ixora yellowing at the roundabout on Mercado Ct. roundabout. Diagnose and treat accordingly. (Pic. 3)



- Treat sedge in turf at the Mercado Ct. roundabout.
- 5. Schedule a pruning event for the Jasmine at the Provencia entrance at Bibiana intersection.
- 6. Pygmy Date Palm is still struggling to push out new growth at the exit side of Provencia. Does this need to be treated or fertilized again?
- 7. Remove Purple Shower growing within the Arboricola at the Provencia roundabout.
- 8. Schedule a pruning event for the Jasmine at the Rosalinda entrance.
- 9. Pygmy Date palm still struggling to push new growth at entrance side of Rosalinda. Does this need to be treated or fertilized again?

- 10. Treat weeds growing in the bed at Felicia Ct. roundabout.
- 11. Treat grassy weeds in bed at Rosalinda roundabout.

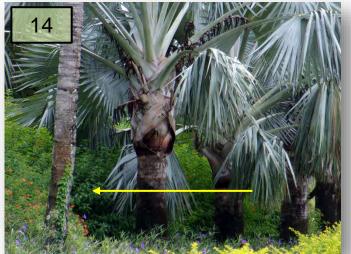


- 1. There are Coconut palms with hanging fronds and fruiting structures on Paseo Dr. from Paseo Grande Blvd. to the bridge.
- Diagnose and treat a couple declining Copperleaf just before you cross the bridge on East and West ROW.
- 3. Joint crack weeds just after you cross the bridge on Paseo Dr.
- 3. Schedule a pruning event for the Firebush across the street from light pole #318 and the rest of zone 5.
- Diagnose and treat Gold Mound on Paseo Dr. across the street from light pole #318. (Pic. 4)



- 5. Hanging palm fronds between light poles #327 and #328.
- Remove dead material out of the Shell Ginger at the intersection of Paseo Dr. and Adelio Ln. on the Southside.
- Prune Ornamental Grasses at the intersection of Paseo Dr. and Adelio Ln. crowding some Croton on the Southside.
- 8. Schedule a pruning event for the Gold Mound at light pole #327 and across the street from it on Paseo Dr.

- 9. Remove dead hanging fronds and fruiting structures out of the palms across the street from Adelio Ln.
- 10. Diagnose and treat small area of stressed turf just South of Dario Way entrance.
- 11. Dead hanging palm fronds on the corner of Dario Way and Paseo Dr.
- 12. Treat weeds in the Croton bed on Paseo Dr. just North of Dario Way.
- 13. Provide plant separation between the Firebush and Pitch Apple that are growing together across the street from Dario Way.
- 14. Remove vine growing up palm tree across the street from the exit side of Dario Way. (Pic. 14)



- 15. Diagnose and treat the Awabuki in decline at the lift station on Paseo Dr.
- 16. Remove vines growing in the Firebush right before you get to Esteban Dr.
- 17. Remove weeds in front of the palm at North intersection of Esteban Dr. and Paseo Dr.
- 18. Large weed growing within the Awabuki on Paseo Dr. near exit side of Esteban Dr. South.



19. Treat crack weeds on Paseo Dr. by light post #356. (Pic. #19)



- 20. Remove large weed growing within the Arboricola just East of light pole #356 on Paseo Dr.
- 21. Treat weeds in the bed on Paseo Dr. across the street from Hildalgo Ct.
- 22. Schedule a pruning event for the Podocarpus across the street from light pole #362.
- 23. New Pitch Apple was installed on Paseo Dr. near Falisto Pl., and they look good.
- 24. There is one Pitch Apple near the newly planted ones that needs to be stood up and staked.
- 25. Remove hanging Coconut Palm fronds near light pole #364.
- 26. Schedule a pruning event for the Coco Plum at the electrical boxes at #365 light post on Paseo Dr.
- 27. Treat broadleaf turf weeds at Paseo Dr. roundabout.



- 1. Cleanout dead fronds in the Paurotis palms at the Adelio Ln. roundabout.
- Treat weeds around the base of the Shady Lady trees on Dario Way on the North ROW. (Pic. 2)



- Remove sucker growth off a Shady Lady on Dario Way on the North ROW.
- 4. Diagnose and treat the turf on the back side of Adora Ct. roundabout.
- Clean out dead frond in Paurotis Palms on Adora Ct. roundabout.
- 6. Diagnose and treat declining turf at the Dario Way roundabout. Looks bad. (Pic. 6)



- 7. It appears there is some type of animal burrowing under the Arboricola at the Dario Way roundabout. Please back fill this hole. If you did fill in last time, we may need to trap or put something down to deter the animal. Was this filled in and then animal came back?
- 8. Schedule a pruning event for the Bougainvillea spikes at the Dario Way roundabout.



1.	Diagnose and treat the turf at the Esteban North Dr. roundabout.
2.	Clean out the dead fronds in the Paurotis palms at Esteban North Dr. roundabout.
3.	Treat paver weeds on Esteban Dr. South by the lift station at light post #392.
4.	Remove dead flowing structures out of the Bird of Paradise at Macario Ct. roundabout.
5.	Treat broadleaf turf weeds on the backside of Esteban Dr. South roundabout.

RESOLUTION 2024-01

REVISED ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION OF THE PASEO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (THE "DISTRICT") RELATING TO REVISED ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND ADOPTING A REVISED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Paseo Community Development District Board of Supervisors (the "Board") previously approved and adopted an annual budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to revise the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Section 190.008(2)(a), Florida Statutes, requires that the District Board by passage of the Annual Appropriation Resolution shall adopt a budget for each fiscal year and appropriate such sums of money as the Board deems necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the District Manager has prepared a revised budget, whereby the revised budget projects the cash receipts and disbursements anticipated during a given time period, including reserves for contingencies for emergency or other anticipated expenditures during the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to reallocate funds budgeted and to re-appropriate revenues and expenses approved for the 2022/2023 fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE PASEO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The Board has reviewed the District Manager's revised budget and hereby approves certain amendments in accordance with Exhibit "A" attached. The revised budget attached hereto is hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. In accordance with Section 189.016, Florida Statutes, the District's management is directed to post the amended budget on the District's website.

- 3. If any provision of this Resolution is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect unless rescinded or repealed.
